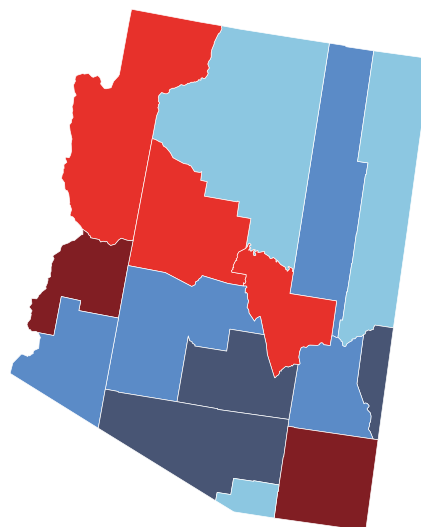

Approximately 96,879 Arizona veterans live in homes with one or more major problems of quality, crowding, or cost. Housing affordability is the greatest housing problem among veterans. Roughly 26.9 percent of Arizona veterans pay too much for their housing.

In 2014, 18,130 VA home loan guarantees were made in Arizona to support veteran homeowners. VA loans represented 11.9 percent of Arizona's home mortgage originations in 2014.
