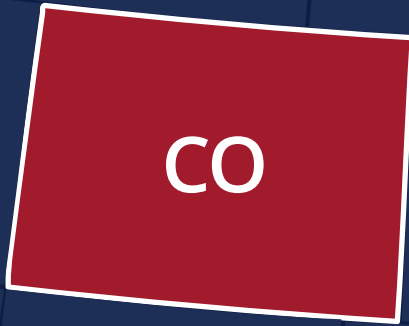

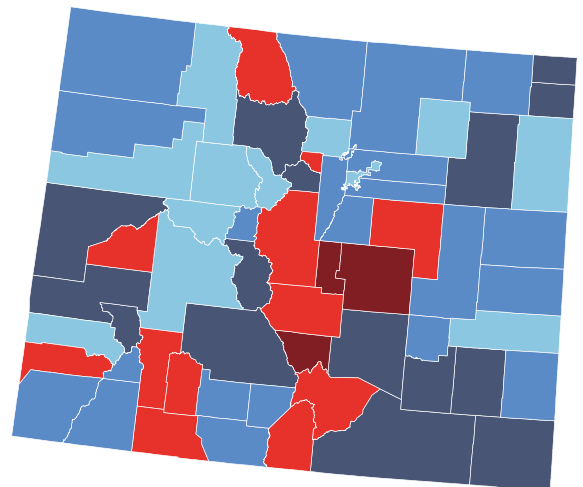

Approximately 68,957 Colorado veterans live in homes with one or more major problems of quality, crowding, or cost. Housing affordability is the greatest housing problem among veterans. Roughly 26.7 percent of Colorado veterans pay too much for their housing.

In 2014, 25,821 VA home loan guarantees were made in Colorado to support veteran homeowners. VA loans represented 11.9 percent of Colorado's home mortgage originations in 2014.
