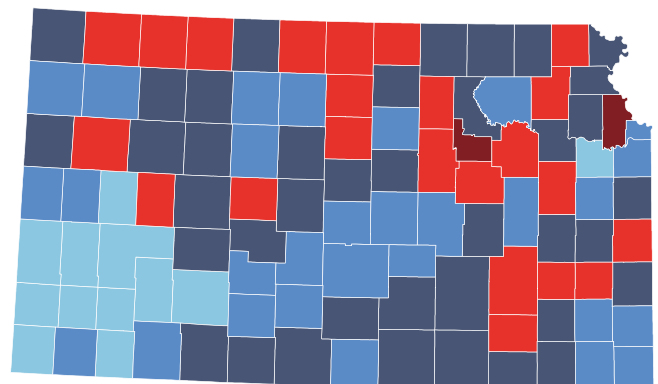

Approximately 27,410 Kansas veterans live in homes with one or more major problems of quality, crowding, or cost. Housing affordability is the greatest housing problem among veterans. Roughly 19.7 percent of Kansas veterans pay too much for their housing.

In 2014, 5,456 VA home loan guarantees were made in Kansas to support veteran homeowners. VA loans represented 9.0 percent of Kansas's home mortgage originations in 2014.
