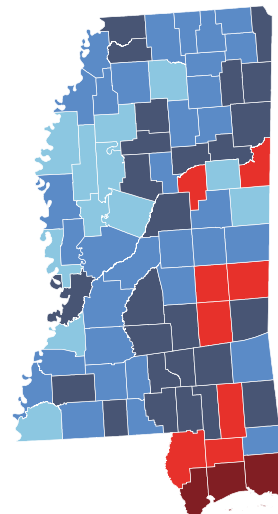

In 2014, 4,910 VA home loan guarantees were made in Mississippi to support veteran homeowners. VA loans represented 9.7 percent of Mississippi's home mortgage originations in 2014.
