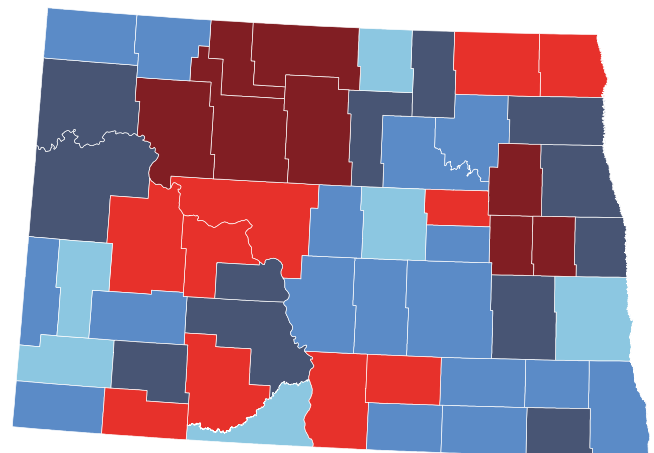

In 2014, 1,434 VA home loan guarantees were made in North Dakota to support veteran homeowners. VA loans represented 8.5 percent of North Dakota's home mortgage originations in 2014.
