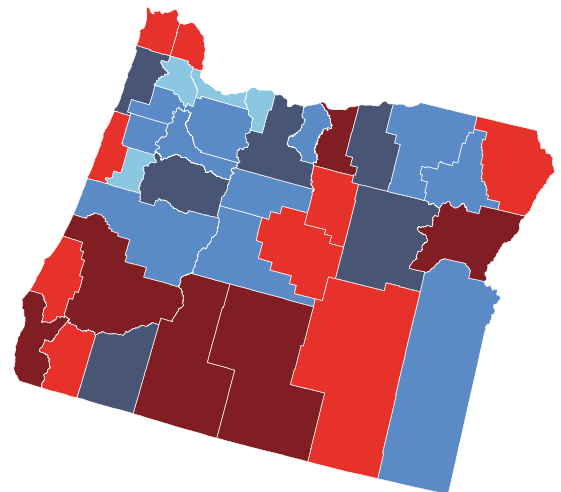

Approximately 59,506 Oregon veterans live in homes with one or more major problems of quality, crowding, or cost. Housing affordability is the greatest housing problem among veterans. Roughly 29.9 percent of Oregon veterans pay too much for their housing.

In 2014, 11,324 VA home loan guarantees were made in Oregon to support veteran homeowners. VA loans represented 9.8 percent of Oregon's home mortgage originations in 2014.
