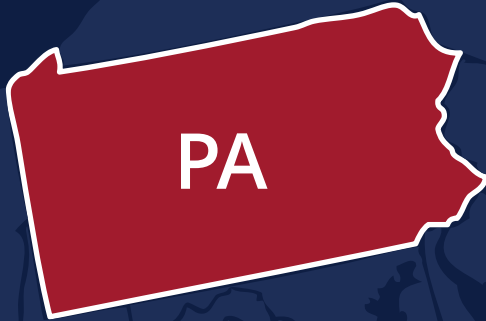

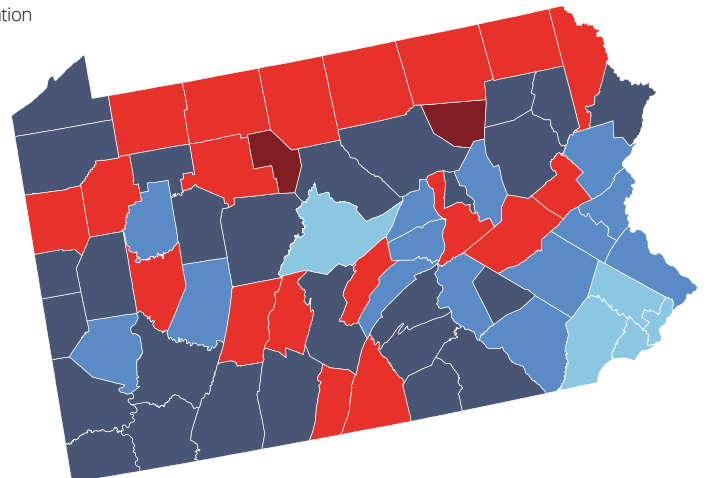

Approximately 139,386 Pennsylvania veterans live in homes with one or more major problems of quality, crowding, or cost. Housing affordability is the greatest housing problem among veterans. Roughly 24.3 percent of Pennsylvania veterans pay too much for their housing.

In 2014, 14,577 VA home loan guarantees were made in Pennsylvania to support veteran homeowners. VA loans represented 5.9 percent of Pennsylvania's home mortgage originations in 2014.
