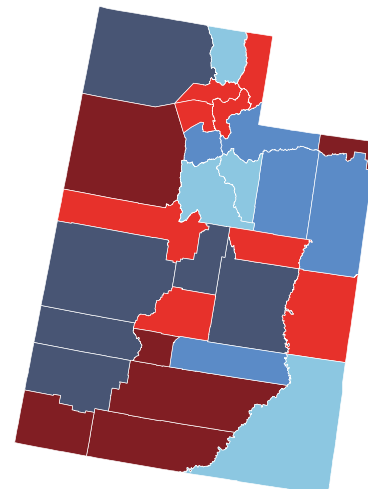

In 2014, 7,201 VA home loan guarantees were made in Utah to support veteran homeowners. VA loans represented 6.7 percent of Utah's home mortgage originations in 2014.
