








## **Veterans by County**

HOUSING & HOMES VETERAN OCCUPIED HOMES 75,122



Approximately 75,122, or 10.6 percent, of West Virginia's homes are occupied by veterans.

HOME VALUE \$135,000



The median value of West Virginia veterans' homes is \$135,000. The state's overall median home value is \$125,000.

HOUSING PROBLEMS

12,372



Approximately 12,372 West Virginia veterans live in homes with one or more major problems of quality, crowding, or cost. Housing affordability is the greatest housing problem among veterans. Roughly 16.0 percent of West Virginia veterans pay too much for their housing.

VA MORTGAGE LOANS 5,258



In 2021, 5,258 VA home loan guarantees were made in West Virginia to support veteran homeowners. VA loans represented 11.0 percent of Wisconsin's home mortgage originations in 2021.

HOME-LESSNESS 122



HUD estimates that approximately 122 West Virginia veterans are homeless.
