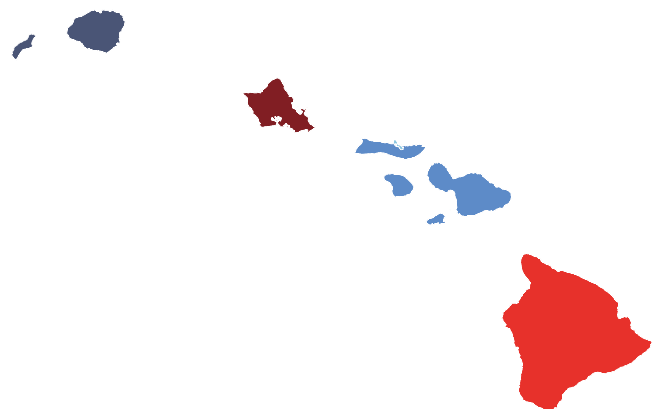
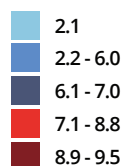

In 2021, 9,965 VA home loan guarantees were made in Hawaii to support veteran homeowners. VA loans represented 16.9 percent of Hawaii's home mortgage originations in 2021.
