Housing affordability is the greatest housing problem among veterans. Roughly 20.8 percent of Kansas veterans pay too much for their housing. 9,989 VA % MORTGAGE LOANS In 2021, 9,989 VA home loan guarantees were made in Kansas to support veteran homeowners. VA loans represented 9.9 percent of Kansas's home mortgage originations in 2021. HOME-195 21 LESSNESS HUD estimates that approximately 195 Kansas veterans are homeless.
