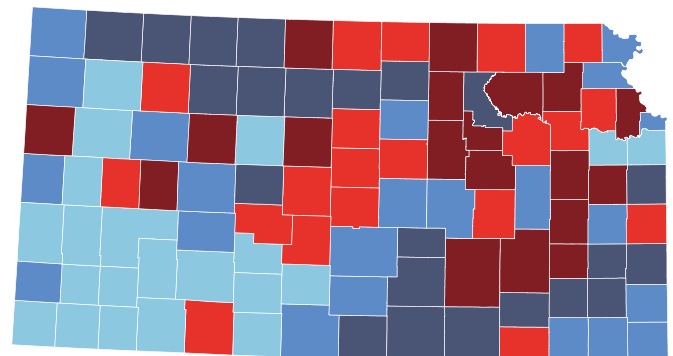

In 2021, 9,989 VA home loan guarantees were made in Kansas to support veteran homeowners. VA loans represented 9.9 percent of Kansas's home mortgage originations in 2021.
