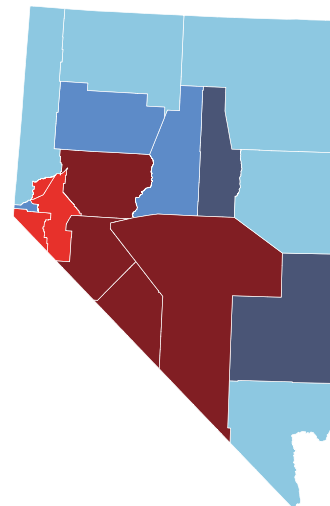

Approximately 41,499 Nevada veterans live in homes with one or more major problems of quality, crowding, or cost. Housing affordability is the greatest housing problem among veterans. Roughly 29.3 percent of Nevada veterans pay too much for their housing.

In 2019, 18,328 VA home loan guarantees were made in Nevada to support veteran homeowners. VA loans represented 16.8 percent of Nevada's home mortgage originations in 2019.
