

HOUSING PROBLEMS

21,084



Approximately 21,084 New Mexico veterans live in homes with one or more major problems of quality, crowding, or cost. Housing affordability is the greatest housing problem among veterans. Roughly 22.4 percent of New Mexico veterans pay too much for their housing.

VA MORTGAGE LOANS 11,071



In 2021, 11,071 VA home loan guarantees were made in New Mexico to support veteran homeowners. VA loans represented 14.9 percent of New Mexico's home mortgage originations in 2021.
