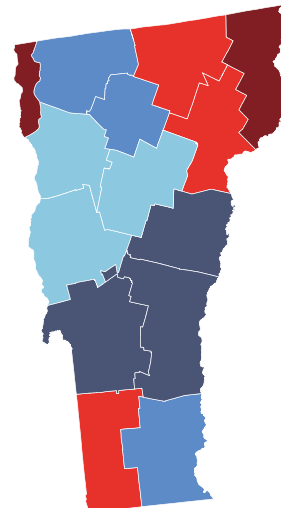

Approximately 5,713 Vermont veterans live in homes with one or more major problems of quality, crowding, or cost. Housing affordability is the greatest housing problem among veterans. Roughly 27.3 percent of Vermont veterans pay too much for their housing.

In 2021, 1,424 VA home loan guarantees were made in Vermont to support veteran homeowners. VA loans represented 5.7 percent of Vermont's home mortgage originations in 2021.
